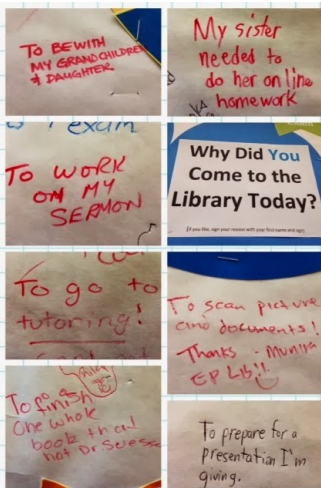

## Upcoming Books

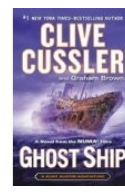
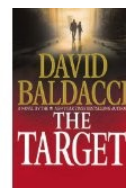
*Destroyer Angel* by **Nevada Barr**. Anna Pigeon, a ranger for the U.S. Park Services, sets off on an autumn canoe trip in upstate Minnesota with her friends and their teenaged daughters. Four thugs, armed with rifles, pistols, and knives, take Anna's friends and daughters captive. With limited resources and no access to the outside world, Anna has only two days to rescue them.

*Keep Quiet* by **Lisa Scottoline**. What starts as a father-son bonding opportunity for Jake and his son Ryan turns into a nightmare with Ryan's entire future hanging in the balance. Jake is forced to make a split-second decision that plunges them both into a world of guilt and lies.

*Carnal Curiosity* by **Stuart Woods**. Stone Barrington seems to have a knack for being in the wrong place at the wrong time. When Manhattan's elite are beset by a series of clever crimes he with his former partner Dino Bacchetti find themselves drawn into the world of high-end security and fraud, where the wealthy are made vulnerable by the very systems meant to keep them safe.

*Ghost Ship* by **Clive Cussler & Graham Brown**. Latest in the NUMA files series. When Kurt Austin is injured attempting to rescue the passengers and crew from a sinking yacht, he wakes with fragmented and conflicted memories.

*The Skin Collector* by **Jeffrey Deaver**. A killer is stalking the basements and underground passageways of New York City. He tattoos his victims' flesh with cryptic messages, using a tattoo gun loaded with poison, resulting in an agonizing, painful death. A con-



nection is made to the Bone Collector-the serial killer who terrorized New York more than a decade ago-Lincoln Rhyme and Amelia Sachs are immediately drawn into the case.

*Night Diver* by **Elizabeth Lowell**. After a family tragedy, Kate Donnelly returns to the Caribbean to help the family's diving business. A dive to recover treasure from the ancient wreck of a pirate ship leads to mystery, romance and danger.

*Cavendon Hall* by **Barbara Taylor Bradford**. Cavendon Hall is home to two families, the aristocratic Ingahams and the Swanns who serve them. With World War I looming, both families will find themselves tested in ways they never thought possible.

*The Target* by **David Baldacci**. The President has the opportunity to take down a global menace, but if the mission fails, he would face certain impeachment, and the threats against the nation would multiply.

## Children's Room News

The **2014 Summer Reading Club** kicks off on Monday, June 9th. The theme for this year is ***Fizz Boom Read***. It includes experiments with food and other fun stuff, learning about plants and animals, and technology. Children ages 3 to 5 can participate in the *Read to Me* program where they can get a prize for completing a reading log with their parents or a caregiver. School-age participants keep track of how much they read using a reading log, and get a prize for each section they complete. They can also win one of three grand prizes: \$50 gift card for Barnes and Noble, \$50 in books of their choice, or \$50 in ride tickets from Knoebels. Registration for the reading club runs from **June 9th to July 5th**. Registration forms will be available at the Children's Librarian's desk. A featured program over the summer is Family Night on Thursdays @ 6pm. These are geared for school-age children, but younger siblings are welcome.
