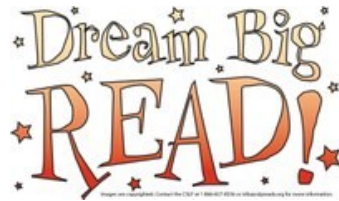

## New Releases

Some upcoming books to watch for by your favorite authors are:

*Third Gate* by **Lincoln Child**: Porter Stone leads an archaeological team to unearth the Egyptian God-King Narmer. After a series of strange events, rumors and tension mount around the possibility of a curse awakened.

*Sweet Talk* by **Julie Garwood**: Olivia MacKenzie, a tough and beautiful lawyer and IRS officer doesn't exactly make fast friends with FBI agent Grayson Kincaid as she stumbles on his sting operation. An unlikely partnership forms in order to battle an enormous Ponzi scheme.

*Judgment Call* by **JA Jance**: Sheriff Joanna Brady is back and facing a conflict of interest when her daughter discovers the body of her high school principal. Joanna is a tough cop and a tougher mom, making for a tense investigation and family drama as truths about her daughter are uncovered.
